

# Measuring for Platforms

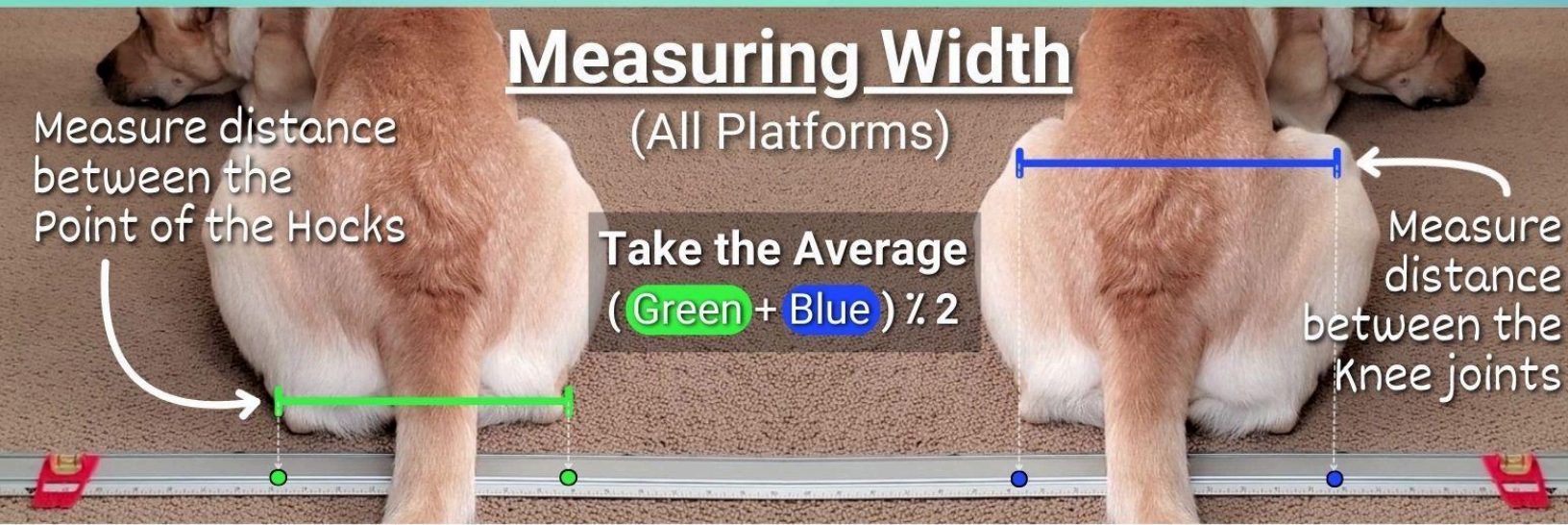
## Measuring Width

Measure distance between the Point of the Hocks

(All Platforms)

Take the Average  
(Green + Blue) % 2

Measure distance between the Knee joints



## Measuring Length

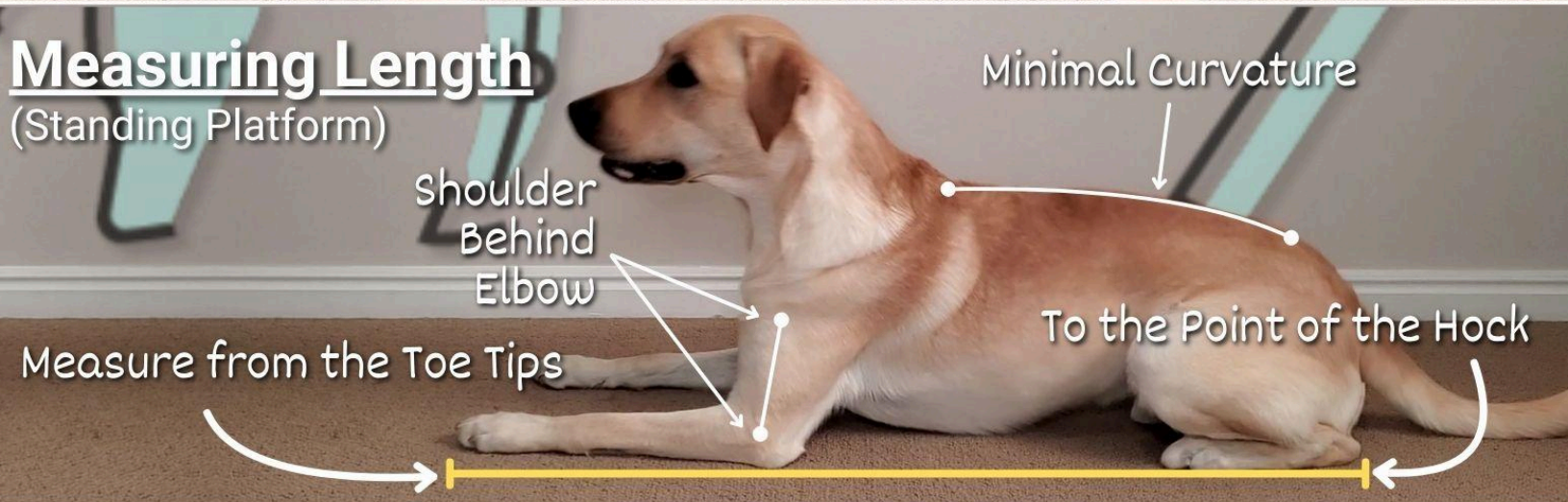
(Standing Platform)

Shoulder Behind Elbow

Minimal Curvature

To the Point of the Hock

Measure from the Toe Tips



## Size Examples

**Ron Burgundy:** Labrador • 75 lbs • 25 inches at the withers  
**Initial Width:** 11 inches **Initial Length:** 38 inches

**Hot Rod:** Border Collie • 39 lbs • 20.5 inches at the withers  
**Initial Width:** 9.5 inches **Initial Length:** 33 inches

**NOTE:** Dogs with the rear limbs tracking mostly parallel will typically be fine with the Green measurement only. Dogs deviating from neutral alignment will need to take the Green + Blue average. When in doubt, err on the side of slightly wider versus slightly too narrow.
